


The Bradfield Walk.

The walk around Bradfield is about 5 miles long and should take you a couple of hours.



Start your walk by going through the gate in the Manor Field – behind the Black Barn (1). Walk diagonally across the field and go through the gate. Cross Back Lane. Directly opposite you is another gate marked ‘public footpath’. Go through the gate and turn right.



Walk along the path with the hedgerow on your right (2). Don't go down the driveway to the farmhouse. Eventually the footpath will turn left. Keep going down the footpath (3). Eventually you will come to a bridge crossing the River Pang (4).



Cross the river and then go through the gates. Turn left and walk along the path. You will come to a footpath which goes up a hill towards a forest (5).




When you meet the forest turn left along the footpath. The footpath now looks like this.  
 Keep walking along the footpath. Eventually you will come to some cottages which look like this. 



Go through the gate which is opposite the cottages. Walk down the pathway  – it goes downhill. Walk to the end of the footpath where it meets another path. Turn right and walk along the footpath.  Eventually you will meet a gate (on the right of a five bar gate). Go through the small gate. The path will lead to a minor road. Walk through the gate by the road and turn right. Go up the road and, very soon, you will meet another gate and public footpath on your left. Go through the gate and follow the public footpath. You should have woods on your left and open land on your right (13).

Eventually you will have the college golf course on your right (15) and the River Pang on your left. Continue along the footpath with the river on your left.



Continue along the footpath. You should pass St Andrew's Church on your right and then you will walk along a road between houses in Bradfield Village. 

You will walk past the mill on your left (24) and then you will come to the main road through Bradfield. Turn left. The road will cross over the mill leat.



Walk along the road until you come to a turning on your left. Turn up this tarmac road which turns to gravel and leads to the Old Gas House (29). Just past the Old Gas House you will see a footpath on the right which leads into the field. Go up this footpath into the field. The footpath will turn diagonally across the field.



Walk right across the field. You will come to a gate which is on Back Lane.


Go through this gate and you will see a 'road' opposite you. 

Go up this road. It will get narrower as you go. Towards the top you will come to 'Greathouse Cottages'. Past these cottages you will see this public footpath sign on your right.



One of the fingerposts points to a footpath opposite on the left hand side of the road. Take this footpath (31).

Keep on this footpath through the forest. Eventually you will see some open

land on your left (32). Keep walking. Ignore the first path on your right by the old pig pen. Take the next footpath on your right by the white post. 

You should follow this footpath and eventually you will come to a field where you can see Rushall Farm. Do not go into the field but take the path



on your right. This will take you to the camp fire site. Walk through the camp fire site and take the footpath on your left. Follow this path until you meet Scratchface Lane.

Walk across the road where you will see the gateway into Rushall Manor Farm. 

Walk along the track back to the Black Barn.
